Code of Conduct

We live together and function as a community of believers in Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord, and seek to honor Him in all we do. Residents and guests are to conduct themselves in a way consistent with Biblical principles and the values of Maranatha. Our scheduled meetings are designed to support and equip you for godly living; faithful attendance is encouraged.

We request your compliance with the following rules at Maranatha:

- 1. All persons (guests, visitors, or residents) must be registered at the Lodge office and hold appropriate identification in order to enjoy use of conference facilities.
- 2. Community quiet time is from 11:30 PM until 7:00 AM.
- 3. Recreational facilities are closed during regular conference services.
- 4. Conduct and dress should reflect the highest standards of Christian modesty, good taste and high moral standards.
- 5. (Please see "Pool Rules" for modesty requirements at the beach.)
- Alcohol, drugs and tobacco are prohibited on conference grounds and in conference buildings.
- 7. If same gender couples are in attendance of MBMC and undermine our position by overt declarations or behaviors, then we will ask them to respect our position by refraining from such declarations or behaviors while on our grounds. If they refuse they will be asked to leave and granted a pro-rated refund of fees paid.
- 8. Same gender couples and unmarried heterosexual couples are also expected to respect our position by not cohabitating at MBMC regardless of their choices elsewhere. Any couples, married or not, of any genders, who engage in overt displays of physical affection publicly will also be asked to curtail their behavior so as not to be a distraction to other guests who are here to focus on a spiritual encounter with God.
- 9. Fires are prohibited on the grounds, except in designated fire rings and with permission.
- 10. Please help keep our beach clean by placing trash in the garbage cans.
- 11. The ONLY vehicles permitted beyond the Channel Road gate are: those belonging to condominium owners, condominium guests, Maranatha Drive or Channel Road residents, legally approved handicapped permits, permitted staff vehicles and emergency vehicles. All other members and guests should park in the Family Life Center lot and either walk or take the Maranatha Shuttle down the hill. Any unauthorized vehicles parked beyond the gate will be ticketed.
- 12. Use of motorcycles, mopeds, motorized scooters and all-terrain vehicles is prohibited on conference grounds and the beach, except on public roadways.
- 13. Skateboards, scooters, roller blades and bicycles are permitted on Maranatha property except as posted on the narrow walkways between the Lodge, Duneside Apartments and the Tabernacle, on stairways (including the condominiums), beyond the gate on Tibet Road, or inside of conference buildings.
- 14. Pets are not permitted in Maranatha rental facilities.
